WHEREAS, general aviation and the Jack Brooks Regional Airport are an important economic engine for Beaumont and the Southeast Texas region; and,

WHEREAS, the state of Texas has a significant interest in the continued vitality of general aviation, aerospace, aircraft manufacturing, aviation organizations and educational institutions and community airports and airport operators; and,

WHEREAS, according to the Texas Department of Transportation, general aviation in Texas supports more than 56,000 jobs, generates \$14.6 billion in economic activity annually, and plays a vital role in the State's response to emergencies and natural disasters; and,

WHEREAS, the nation's aviation infrastructure represents an important public benefit; and,

WHEREAS, according to the FAA, there are 391 public-use airports in the state serving 49,616 pilots and 18,500 active general aviation aircraft;
