WHEREAS, the Idaho Transportation Department, Division of Aeronautics reports that Idaho has 117 public-use general

aviation airports. According to FAA data, these airports serve 4,834 pilots and 2,966 active general aviation aircraft;

WHEREAS, according to a PricewaterhouseCoopers study, Contribution of General Aviation to the US Economy., general aviation

in Idaho contributes over \$1.1 billion to the state's total economic output; and

WHEREAS, according to the PricewaterhouseCoopers' study, Contribution of General Aviation to the US Economy, general

aviation supports 7,900 jobs in Idaho, resulting in \$342 million in labor income; and

WHEREAS, general aviation not only supports Idaho's economy, it improves overall quality of life by supporting emergency

medical and healthcare services, law enforcement, firefighting and disaster relief, and by transporting business

travelers to their destinations quickly and safely; and

**WHEREAS,** the state nation's aviation infrastructure confers important public benefits, and;

WHEREAS, congressional oversight should be secured to ensure stable funding of general aviation as a vital and strategic

resource.
