



## **MAYORAL PROCLAMATION RECOGNIZING GENERAL AVIATION APPRECIATION MONTH**

WHEREAS, general aviation and the Camdenton Memorial-Lake Regional Airport play a critical role in the lives of our citizens, as well as in the operation of our businesses and farms; and

WHEREAS, the State of Missouri has a significant interest in the continued vitality of general aviation, aerospace, aircraft manufacturing, educational institutions, aviation organizations, community airports and community operators; and

WHEREAS, the State of Missouri boasts 122 public-use airports, which serve 8,825 pilots and 3,985 active general aviation aircraft; and

WHEREAS, general aviation plays a vital role in the State's response to emergencies and natural disasters; and

WHEREAS, the nation's aviation infrastructure represents an important public benefit, and direct Congressional oversight is necessary to ensure stable funding of this system; and

WHEREAS, Missouri is home to 58 repair stations, seven FAA-approved pilot schools, 1,932 student pilots, 1,604 flight instructors and 93 fixed-base operators; and

WHEREAS, many communities in Missouri depend heavily on general aviation and community airports for the continued flow of commerce, tourists, and visitors to our state.

NOW THEREFORE, I, John D. McNabb, Mayor of the City of Camdenton, do hereby proclaim general aviation a vital strategic resource to the City of Camdenton and declare March 2019 as
